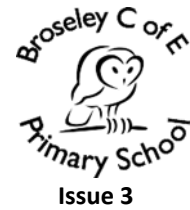

Dear Parents,

Firstly, I would like to thank you all for your kind understanding about the closure of the school due to the water situation. I am still phoning for regular updates and have been very pleased to have been able to open the school today. I have been informed that the water in the taps is not yet suitable for drinking, but we have had a large delivery of bottled water and we have also been using the bottled water for cooking with. If we have the slightest concern that school is unfit for pupils, please be reassured that you will be contacted asap and steps will be taken to deal immediately with the situation.

I would like to say a big thank you to everyone who came along to our 50th 'Birthday Bash' on Saturday. Lots of fun was had by all, and even the drizzle failed to dampen our spirits! It was extremely well-organised by our wonderful PTA led by Lindsay Anson, and we are very grateful to everyone who gave up their time to volunteer their support.

One of the things that we are trying to develop further in school is listening to our pupils more and allowing them to contribute to the way school is run. Some of our new initiatives that have come from pupils include a 'buddy bus stop' which goes in each playground and is a place where other children can go if they need someone to play with. There will be a competition this week for pupils to design the signs on the bus stops which we will then get made for the playgrounds. We also have a designated quiet area in the playground where pupils can go if they would like a moment to themselves, and at lunchtime we have an option for pupils to play indoor games with their friends, supervised by our very efficient Year 6 prefects. We will also be developing a friendship support group called 'Broseley buddies'. This week will also see our new school council being elected and I will be giving the pupils really informative questionnaires about their experience at school on which they can tell us how we could improve things further.

I am afraid we have had to change the date for the Hallowe'en disco because of a timetable clash with the use of the school hall. The disco will now take place on Thursday 2nd November from 5 pm until 6.30 pm. Pupils can have fun dressing up if they wish and we will have lots of prizes to be won.
