Dear Parents,

First of all, I have to let you know how proud I am of every single member of our school community. As you know, we had an inspection last Thursday which is due to the fact that we are a Church of England school. It was very similar to an OFSTED inspection – certainly as rigorous! – and some of you were able to come in and speak to the inspectors about your experience as a parent. The inspector was very impressed with those parents he spoke to, and I have to thank you for the positive way in which you spoke about school. I know that some of you wanted to speak to the inspectors but were unable to due to work commitments and it was very kind of you to email us your views. Again, these were shared with the inspectors. We are not allowed to share the outcome of the inspection until the official report is published, but as soon as we have the result, we will share it with you. The pupils, as always, were awesome and demonstrated the high levels of kindness, generosity and support to each other that we have come to expect at our school. The staff didn't do too badly either!

We have had a couple of reports of people not parking correctly outside the front of school, which inevitably results in the safety of our pupils and families being compromised. Our new parking system has been successful, but we do need everybody to be using it correctly. Parking on the paths and near to the raised speed humps is not permitted. It is extremely dangerous for many reasons.

We have an author in school this week working with all of the classes each day in the morning. Gemma Brown is the author of 'The Marvellous Marathon Dragon' and she is doing Literacy workshops with the pupils. We will be sending a letter home later on in the week giving you more information on this, and how we might help to support her charity 'Cameron's Fund' at Asthma UK.

Very excitingly, as you may have seen on Facebook, we have a date for Christingle – Monday 11th December at 10am. This, for many, is a truly magical part of our Broseley Christmas and has been greatly missed over the past five years. We hope you will be able to join us at the church where pupils will be performing poems and songs, as well as filling the church with light. The PTA have 223 christingles to make (which is a lot of oranges!) and would really appreciate any help on offer.

Thank you again for all your support last week; I would like to extend a personal thanks on behalf of all of the staff for really going that extra mile for us.




We raised a fantastic £638.25

Thank you very much to those who took part and for helping us to raise this fantastic amount of money for our new library.


We will be purchasing lots of new books over the coming months.
